
## Set Free Prison Ministries Since 1971

Dear Friends,

Thank you for your prayers, loving generosity, and your heart to reach those behind prison walls for our Lord Jesus Christ.

We are praising God for His unwavering faithfulness. This September we entered our 55th year of full-time prison ministry!

We are rejoicing in the mighty power of the Gospel. Scores of inmates continue to open their hearts to the heaven-sent Savior. They are now children of God and have been set free from the penalty of sin (John 8:36; Romans 6:23).

Presently they are being **set free from** the power of sin. They are experiencing new victory over sin through the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit.

He not only illuminates God's Word but also empowers and enables them to live in a new way—one that brings glory to the Lord, Who purchased them with His precious blood (1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 2 Corinthians 5:17). This is a daily journey for each of us (Galatians 5:16-26).

In the future, we all look forward to that glorious day, when we will be completely set free from the very presence of sin. That will happen when we see Him face-to-face. We will be like Him—never again to sin or grieve His tender heart in thought, word, or deed. What a wonderful day - and forever that will be (1 John 3:2; Revelation 21:1-5).

To date, 1,037 inmates have made professions of faith while completing their Bible courses!

This is 100% the work of the Lord, and to Him be all the glory. We, along with the angels in heaven, rejoice over every sinner who repents and opens their heart to the Savior. The bottom line is this: where sin abounds, grace abounds much more (Romans 5:20). The prison mission field is truly white unto harvest (John 4:35-36).

We at Set Free, continue to minister to over 6,000 inmates every month. During the first eight months of this year, we averaged 825 new enrollments per month. But, this past September, We wonderfully received 1,093 new enrollments! This is an increase of 268 over the previous monthly average. We took a major step of faith by sending out extra prepaid enrollment cards to our active students, encouraging them to give to other inmates.

Last month, we received Bible study requests from 1,093 inmates across the United States. Thanks to your faithful prayers and generous support, each one of these requests has been filled. Please continue to pray for their salvation. May the seeds of God's Word take root in their hearts and bear lasting fruit for His glory.



This also gave them additional opportunities to share the Gospel. All new requests were promptly processed. Each received a free Bible course along with other excellent materials which make the Gospel crystal clear.

Interestingly, 155 of these requests were from Hispanic inmates, many of whom are soon to be deported. The vast majority are devastated, fearful, and without God and hope. Our goal in the coming months is to reach as many as possible with the Gospel - so that when they return to their country of origin, they have been born again to a living hope, with a new citizenship, and a passport to heaven (1 Peter 1:3 and 19-20).

Please pray for us - that the Lord would give us wisdom, guide, favor and opportunities to share the Gospel to those in tightly closed incarceration centers.

It's very clear that there is an increasing spiritual hunger, growing behind prison walls. What is especially great is that each inmate has personally reached out to Set Free for spiritual help.

Where there is no vision, the people perish.... Proverbs 29:18

All are seeking God, forgiveness, inner peace, life's meaning, victory over sins and spiritual help to change the painful direction of their lives.

The Lord said, we are not only to go into all the world and preach the Gospel, but also to make disciples. This too, has been our all-consuming desire for over five decades (Mark16:15; Matthew 28:19-20).

To make this happen, we continue to offer an extensive and excellent Bible study curriculum in both English and in Spanish. Along with the studies, we send a New Testament study Bible that clearly presents the message of salvation and is filled with challenging personal applications. The last two-thirds of our curriculum consists of Christian growth courses — covering doctrine, discipleship, and evangelism, and more. Everything we offer is completely free of charge, including mailing and return postage.

I never get tired of saying. "Set Free is the Lord's ministry. Every day that we operate a 100% free ministry to the destitute, is a miracle of the Lord's provision through the loving generosity of His wonderful people."

Words fail to express our heartfelt gratitude for your prayers and faithful financial support. Many of you have partnered with Set Free for many decades -through prayer, service, or giving. Please know how much we appreciate you. Our ongoing commitment to you is to make every dollar count for the glory of the Lord in furthering the Gospel.

Every month, we receive hundreds of completed introductory Bible study courses from new students all across the United States.

Once received, our Set Free staff enters each course into our computer system. Then, we promptly assign the second course, along with additional Gospel booklets, to be mailed to the student.

The inmate's first completed course is then sent to Set Free coordinators and individual volunteers in various states for review. This process—between mailing, correction, and return—can take up to three weeks before the inmate receives their corrected first course and a certificate of completion. Such delays can be discouraging, especially for someone who has taken the first step to study God's Word.

That is why a timely response is absolutely critical to keep their spiritual interest strong and a desire to complete additional courses.

In April of this year, we launched a new initiative called "Set Free First

Responders." This local mentor team is made up of believers from nearby evangelical churches—serves right from the Set Free office. Every Wednesday, they meet at the Set Free office. Their mission is to review the first course - Knowing Jesus Christ, respond quickly to inmates' questions about salvation, and pray, mentor, and encourage them. This new team is now fully trained and rolling smoothly.

We are happy to report that we can now return the first complete course to new students within 10 days.

This initiative has become a great blessing to both the inmates and Set Free. It has also been encouraging and exciting to witness our First Responders grow in their own faith, confidently and boldly sharing the Gospel with others in the free world.

We are truly grateful to the Lord for touching hearts and raising up additional volunteers who are serving the Lord as they minister to those behind bars.




## LETTERS FROM INMATES
